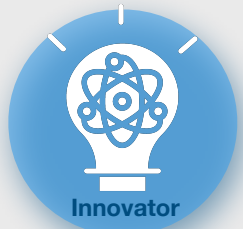

9-12TH GRADE

Our students continue to focus on exploring their college options by utilizing their CCGI accounts. Students are exposed to a variety of experiences and opportunities focused on college readiness. Experiences at Summit High School provide students the skills, knowledge, and behaviors needed to be successful in college.

6-8TH GRADE

TK-5TH GRADE

Starting as early as elementary, students get exposed to different career options and get the opportunity to create their own personal and postsecondary goals.

Students begin to build their knowledge of career academy options and potential areas of interest. Many opportunities are provided to explore personal interests and necessary skills for various career options.

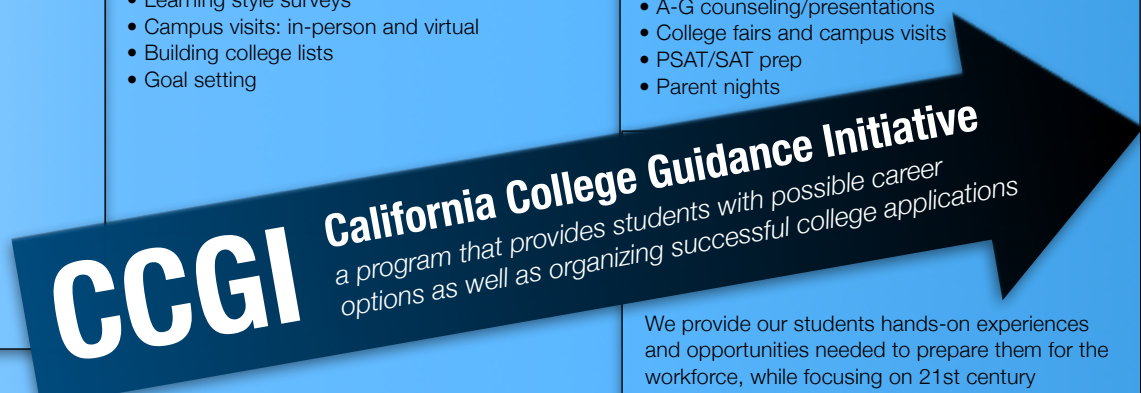
Examples:
